## FIG at Home EXPLODING SHAPES

Banish boredom with this STEAM project that uses simple materials found in many households.

## **MATERIALS**

- · Baking soda
- Vinegar
- Water
- Mixing bowl
- Small cup
- Baking pan or plate with sides
- Dropper (clean medicine dropper or a straw)
- Cookie cutters
- Washable tempera paint or food coloring (optional)

## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Combine 4 parts baking soda to 1 part water (suggestion: 1/2 cup baking soda and 2 tablespoons water. The mix should hold its shape when squeezed. Add water until it does)
- 2. Add small amount of color paint or food coloring to mixture
- 3. Tightly pack each cookie cutter with the mixture
- 4. Carefully lift the cookie cutters off the mixture
- 5. Pour a small amount of vinegar into a cup
- 6. Use dropper or straw to drop vinegar onto each shape
- 7. Watch the shapes bubble, fizz, and explode!
