PENNY SPINNER

Kids will be mesmerized by these fun and easy spinners!

MATERIALS

- Cardboard
- Printer and printer paper
- Spinner template (included)
- Crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- Scissors
- Glue
- Pennies



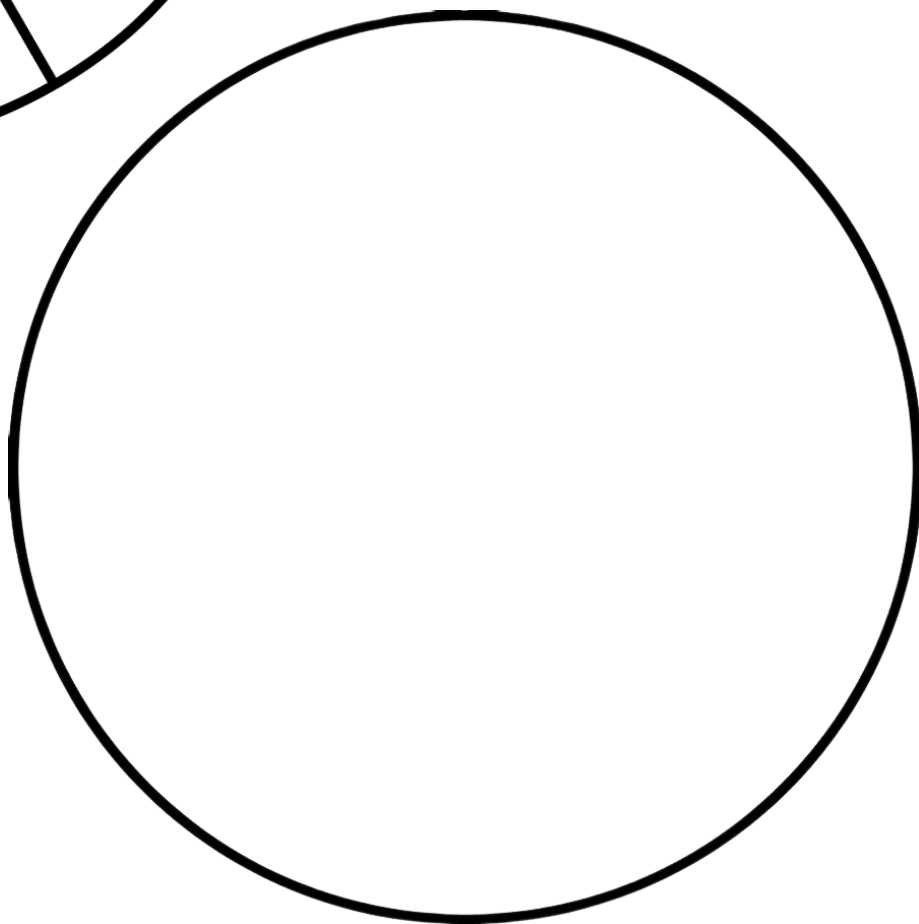
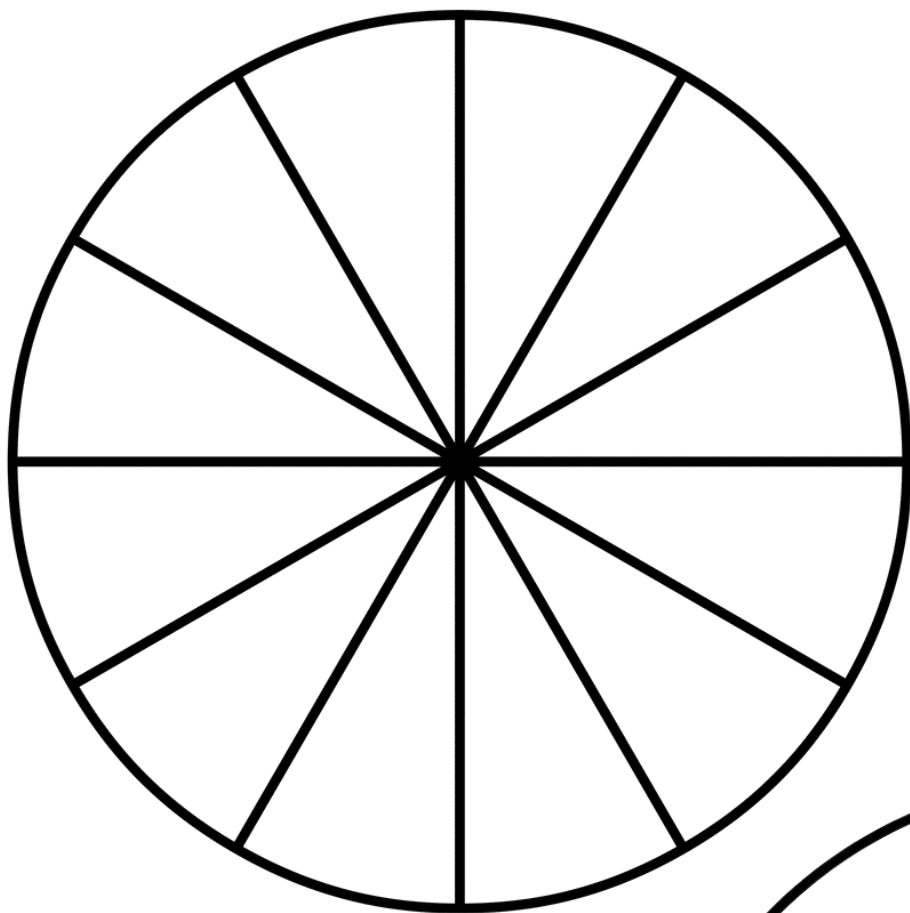
INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print out the spinner template. If you do not have access to a printer, draw your own. Trace a bowl with about a 5-6" diameter onto paper.
2. Color in the template or design your own.
3. Cut out the paper circle and trace it onto cardboard. Any thickness of cardboard is fine. Try recycling a cereal box or shoe box.
4. Cut out the cardboard circle.
5. Find the center point of the cardboard circle, and cut a small slit for the penny with scissors. Make sure the slit is not too big or the penny will fall through. Little hands will need some extra help with this step.
6. Glue the paper circle onto the cardboard.
7. Find the center slit and push the penny halfway through the paper and the cardboard.
8. Give your spinner a twist and watch it twirl!

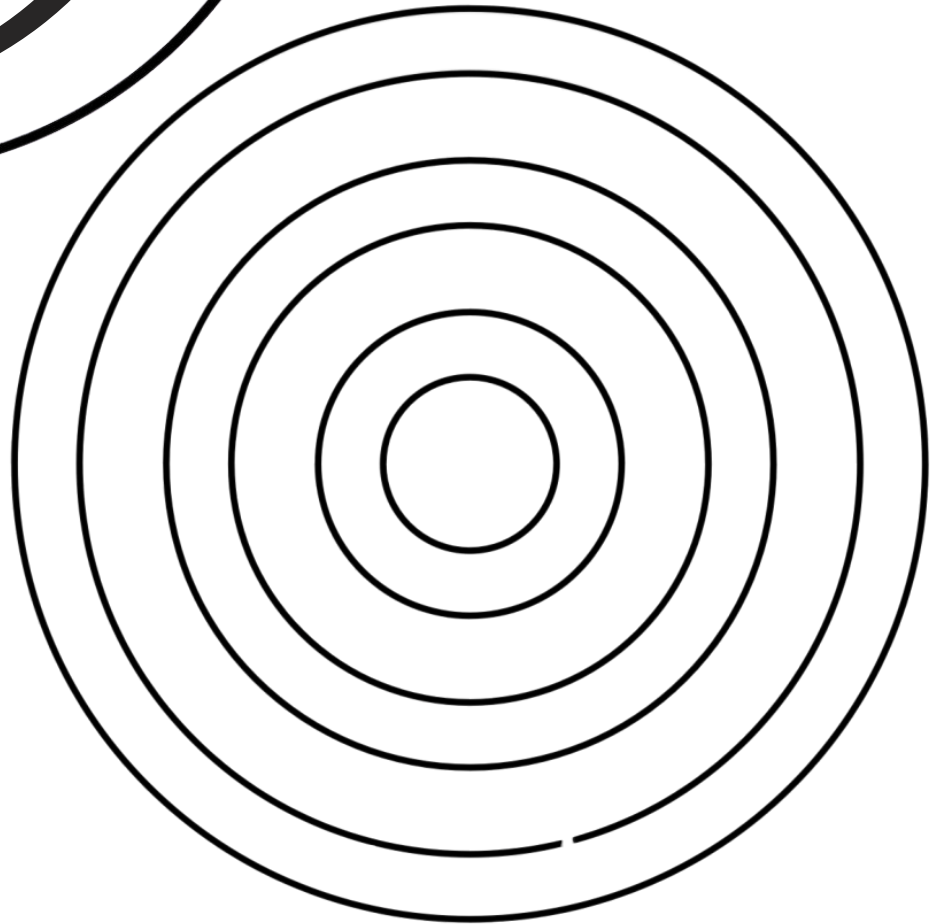
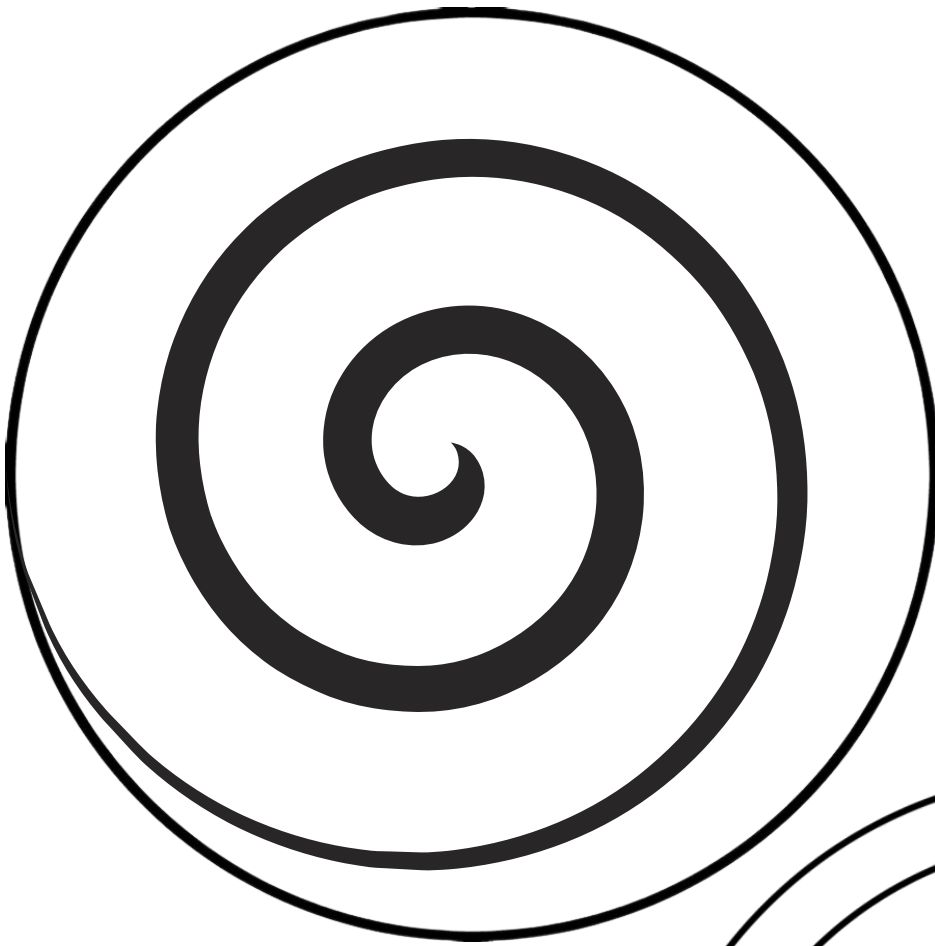
