BUBBLE WRAP RAINDROPS

Utilize recycled bubble wrap to explore a paint process that really pops!

MATERIALS

- Printer and printer paper
- Umbrella template (included)
- Markers, colored pencils, or crayons
- Paintbrush or foam brush
- Blue paint
- Bubble wrap
- Scissors and glue
- Newspaper or paper bag

INSTRUCTIONS

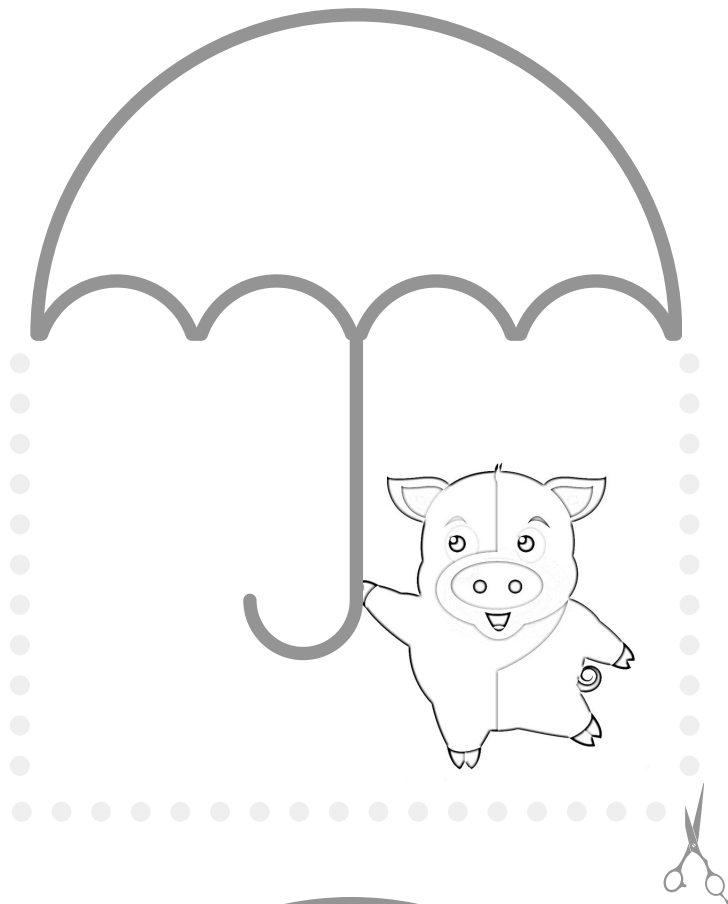
1. Start by protecting your work area with newspaper or a recycled paper grocery bag.
2. Choose a plain piece of paper for your background and set it aside.
3. Print out the umbrella template. Optional: draw your own umbrella and character on the background.
4. Color the umbrella and draw a character holding the umbrella. We've included an extra umbrella with our FIG mascot, Figlet, if you want to include him.
5. Cut out and glue your umbrella and character onto the background. Align with the bottom edge.
6. Cut out the cover piece (included) and place it over the umbrella and character. Align with the umbrella.
7. Paint the bumpy side of your bubble wrap with a thin layer of blue paint.
8. Carefully turn the bubble wrap over, align it with the bottom edge, and lay it on your background.
9. Softly pat the bubble wrap to make it rain.
10. Pull off the bubble wrap and the protective cover to reveal your masterpiece!
