

# FIG at Home

## HAPPY HEDGEHOG

Let's get to the point. This hedgehog "quill" make your day!

### MATERIALS

- Construction paper or cardstock
- Hedgehog template (included)
- Markers or crayons
- Colorful leaves
- Scissors
- Glue

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print and cut out the hedgehog template.
2. Color the body of the hedgehog, then add features including an eye, mouth, and nose.
3. Glue the hedgehog onto construction paper or cardstock.
4. Pour some glue onto scrap paper.
5. Dip the leaves into the glue then onto the back of the hedgehog. Overlap the leaves starting from the tail end and moving towards the head.
6. Make sure the glue is completely dry before hanging your leafy creature on the fridge.

Options: You can cut out the body of the hedgehog, and glue it on top of the leaves. Or draw your own hedgehog directly onto construction paper then add the leaves.

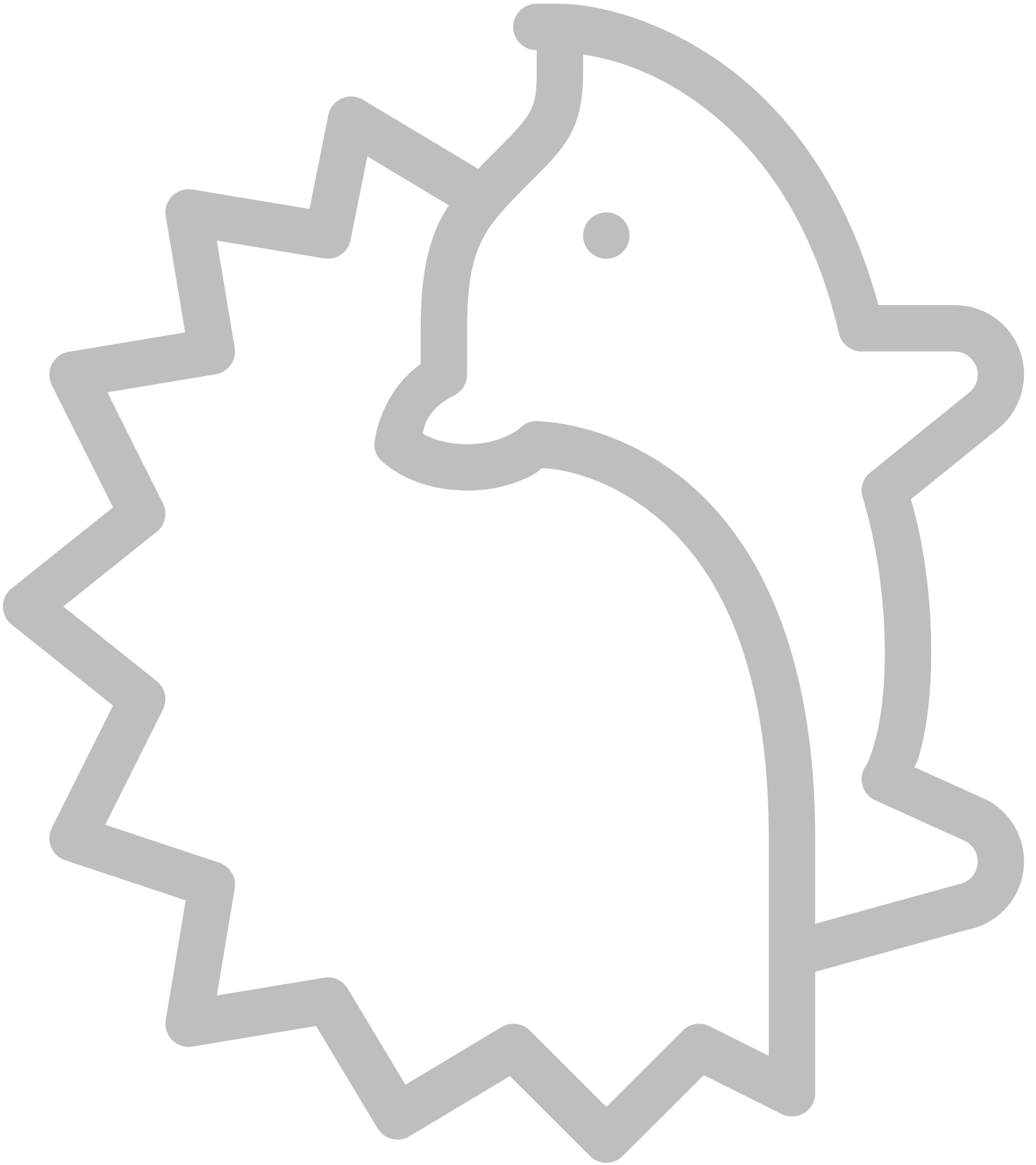
