MOSAIC SNOWFLAKE

"What time is it? It's snow time!" Create a snowflake as unique as you.

MATERIALS

- Cardstock or printer paper
- Snowflake template (included)
- Colored paper (suggest shades of blue)
- Glue or glue stick
- Scissors



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print out the snowflake template (included) on cardstock or regular printer paper.
2. Layer the colored paper and cut it into roughly $\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares. We chose cool shades of blue and purple.
3. Run a thin line of glue through the inside of the snowflake outline.
4. Randomly place the paper squares on the snowflake or create a pattern filling the entire snowflake.
5. Let it dry completely and admire a snowflake as unique as you!
