BUBBLE WAND

Making bubbles is magical when you wave your own special bubble wand!

MATERIALS

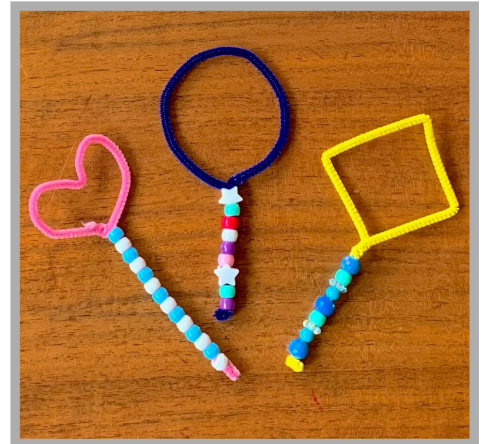
- Pipe cleaners
- Beads
- Optional: homemade bubble solution - includes water, liquid dish soap, corn syrup or glycerine

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Start by deciding what shapes you want to make your bubble wands, such as hearts, circles, or stars. The bigger the shape, the bigger the bubbles!
2. Form the shape at one end of the pipe cleaner. When you reach the end of the shape, wrap the remaining pipe cleaner section around the shape a few times to close it shut. The remaining part of the pipe cleaner becomes the wand handle.
3. Thread the bubble wand handle with colorful beads until you reach the bottom of the pipe cleaner.
4. Twist the end of the pipe cleaner to keep the beads from falling off.
5. Dip the pipe cleaner shape down into a bubble solution and then blow bubbles through your bubble wand.

Need bubble solution? Try our homemade recipe:

1. Pour 3 cups of water into a bowl.
2. Pour 1 cup of liquid dish soap into the bowl.
3. Pour $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of corn syrup or glycerine into a bowl.
4. Carefully stir to mix all ingredients.
5. Dip, don't stir, bubble wand into the solution, and blow bubbles!



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
