## FIG at Home BUBBLE WAND

Making bubbles is magical when you wave your own special bubble wand!

## **MATERIALS**

- · Pipe cleaners
- Beads
- Optional: homemade bubble solution includes water, liquid dish soap, corn syrup or glycerine



## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Start by deciding what shapes you want to make your bubble wands, such as hearts, circles, or stars. The bigger the shape, the bigger the bubbles!
- 2. Form the shape at one end of the pipe cleaner. When you reach the end of the shape, wrap the remaining pipe cleaner section around the shape a few times to close it shut. The remaining part of the pipe cleaner becomes the wand handle.
- 3. Thread the bubble wand handle with colorful beads until you reach the bottom of the pipe cleaner.
- 4. Twist the end of the pipe cleaner to keep the beads from falling off.
- 5. Dip the pipe cleaner shape down into a bubble solution and then blow bubbles through your bubble wand.

Need bubble solution? Try our homemade recipe:

- 1. Pour 3 cups of water into a bowl.
- 2. Pour 1 cup of liquid dish soap into the bowl.
- 3. Pour  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of corn syrup or glycerine into a bowl.
- 4. Carefully stir to mix all ingredients.
- 5. Dip, don't stir, bubble wand into the solution, and blow bubbles!
