FIGGY PIGGY BANK

Recycling a container to create a piggy bank makes a lot of cents!

MATERIALS

- Scissors
- Tape (optional: double-sided tape)
- Markers or crayons
- Paper (big enough to cover empty can)
- Empty can with a lid (coffee, tennis balls, Pringles, Play-Doh)



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Start by cutting out a small piece from the center of the lid just big enough for coins to fit through. This is a task for an adult and easier with an Exacto knife.
2. Measure and cut your paper to the length of the can. The paper should be long enough to wrap it around the entire can.
3. Tape one end of the paper to your container. Wrap in around the can and tape the other end to secure it in place. Double-sided tape works best.
4. Label and decorate your piggy bank with shapes, stickers, or markers.
5. Add the lid and your piggy bank is ready to use!

Option: Make 3 piggy banks and label them as Save, Spend, and Share. Discuss saving up for a special event or item, managing cash, and the power of giving by donating to a cause close to your heart.
